- **Medium:** drawing/painting, watercolor, sculpture, mixed media, textile, photography
- **Size:** Up to 8' (must fit through a standard doorframe to access the gallery)
- **Due:** Submit your proposal by July 31 to [info@visionsofthewild.org](mailto:info@visionsofthewild.org)

Submit photos of existing works you would like to exhibit or a draft of your proposed new artwork if you choose. **Submissions will be reviewed and selected based on what best aligns with the theme of Re•Generation.**
